MUSIC MUST be kept at a REASONABLE <u>VOLUME</u>; that determination will be made by the Event Manager the day of the event. DJ's, Recorded Music or any other forms of AMPLIFIED MUSIC will NOT be permitted.

Establishment wishing to sell BEER or WINE: Please see the reverse page for step by step mandatory guidelines. You must submit a copy of your current valid SLA Permit along with this event application by the deadline of <u>May 1st 2019</u>

Guidelines to Sell Beer or Wine

- 1. Clearview Productions MUST receive your Event Application with a copy of your **CURRENT VALID SLA PERMIT** for submission to the mayors' office. **Deadline- May 1**st **2019.**
- 2. In order to meet NYC/ SLA regulations you are required to purchase a <u>minimum</u> of two (2) 10x10 spaces directly in front of your establishment, one for the sale of Beer & Wine and the other for the consumption.
- A separate one day Temporary Beer and Wine license must be obtained from the SLA 30 days prior to the event. The SLA has introduced a new application process online, to apply go to <u>https://sla.ny.gov/permitsavailable-online#one-day-beer-and-wine-permit</u>, for further information you may contact the SLA at (518) 453-8130.
- 4. Once you have received your Temporary License from the SLA you MUST submit a copy to Clearview Productions- please forward license to <u>chris@clearviewfestival.com</u> **Deadline- May 14th 2019**
- 5. Day of Festival- It is the responsibility of the individual merchant to monitor and control the consumption of Beer or Wine during the event. Consumption MUST be limited to the space(s) purchased within the festival for that purpose. No patrons may be allowed to leave the merchants premises with any alcoholic beverages. Consumption area must be clearly cordoned off. Sale and consumption to end promptly at 6pm. Failure to comply with any of the above guidelines, state laws/ regulations and or verbal instructions from Clearview management and or local authorities the day of the festival will be grounds for immediate forfeiture of any establishments' right to sell beer or wine at the festival as well as future festivals.
